

COLLEGE UNIFORM REGULATIONS

Health & Physical Education (HPE) Uniform



1. Burgundy, grey and white tracksuit top
2. Burgundy, grey and white polo top
3. Striped rugby top
4. Grey sports shorts
5. Dark Grey tracksuit pants (must be worn in winter / terms 2-3)
6. White ankle sports socks
7. Grey bucket hat OR grey/burgundy baseball cap, as supplied
8. Black racer-back swimsuit (College Swimming Team)
9. Lace up runners which provide orthopaedic support. Street shoes, converse, canvas runners, high tops or similar fashion shoes are not permitted.
10. Plain black hair accessories

Summer Uniform - (Worn in Terms 1 and 4. A changeover period may be advised.)



1. Striped dress, knee length
2. Charcoal grey College jumper (Years 7-10), marle grey College jumper (Years 11-12).
3. Burgundy blazer
4. White socks, long.
5. Optional: Charcoal grey College vest (Years 7-10), marle grey College vest (Years 11-12)
6. Plain black lace-up shoes, to provide best foot support and protection. Buckle shoes or T-bar shoes are not permitted.
7. Optional: College scarf (not permitted to be worn in class time)
8. Plain black hair accessories

COLLEGE UNIFORM REGULATIONS

Winter Uniform - (Worn in Terms 2 and 3. A changeover period may be advised.)



1. Long sleeved white shirt, as supplied
2. Striped winter skirt, knee length
3. Charcoal grey College jumper (Years 7-10), marle grey College jumper (Years 11-12)
4. Burgundy blazer
5. Black stockings / Tights (minimum 40 denier).
(socks must not be worn with the Winter Uniform)
6. Optional: Charcoal grey College vest (Years 7-10), marle grey College vest (Years 11-12)
7. Optional: College scarf (not permitted to be worn in class time)
8. Plain black lace-up school shoes, to provide best foot support and protection. Buckle shoes or T-bar shoes are not permitted
9. Plain black hair accessories

Blazer and Jumper (applies to all students Years 7-12)

1. Students are required to wear the blazer to and from school during Terms 2 and 3.
2. The blazer may be required to be worn on official occasions.
3. The jumper or the vest are not permitted to be worn as the outer garment outside of the school grounds at any time.
4. The summer dress may be worn without the blazer to and from school during Terms 1 and 4.

Hair

1. Neat and well groomed. The College reserves the right to suspend any student who has an extreme hairstyle and/or unnatural colours, until she rectifies the situation.
2. Hair that is shoulder length or longer must be neatly and fully tied back at all times.
3. Plain accessories must always be black in colour (ie ribbons, clips, headbands, and hair slides).

Makeup

1. Makeup is not permitted.

Nails

1. Nails should be trimmed and short
2. Coloured nail polish is not permitted.

Jewellery

Students are permitted to wear:

1. A watch.
2. A holy medal or cross, concealed.
3. School badges, as approved and issued by the College.
4. One matching pair of stud earrings, worn anywhere in the ear. Studs may be:
 - a. any colour, other than fluoro colours.
 - b. any shape, provided that the diameter or equivalent is not greater than 3mm.

Please note:

Sleeper or hoop style are not permitted.

Diamante or gem type studs are permitted provided they conform with the above.

Nose or lip piercings are only to be worn with small, clear 'spacers' without a stud.

Chewing gum is not permitted
